whereof or whereto I or any person or persons in trust for me
am or are or at the time of my decease shall or may be seized
possessed or entitled unto my dear wife Merian her heirs executors
administrators and assigns for ever or for all my estate and
interest therein respectively as and for her and their own absolute
property I give devise and bequeath all estates void in me upon
any trust in by way of mortgage unto my said wife her heirs
Executors administrators and assigns upon the trusts affecting
the same respectively I appoint my said wife sole Executrix of this
my will I revoke all Wills at any time heretofore made and declare
this to be my last Will and Testament *In Witness* whereof I have
herunto set my hand this eleventh day of October in the year of Our said
One thousand eight hundred and sixty nine
